We believe that no child should have to sleep in a car, in a park, or under a bridge, and that every family deserves a chance to be whole and have a roof over their head again.



EMERGENCY SHELTER: INTERFAITH HOSPITALITY NETWORK (IHN)

Myia's Story -

"When we came to Family Promise my children and I had nothing but the clothes on our backs. We had been staying in an old, broken-down RV that belonged to a local church. There were no services for us in our own area, so the church called Family Promise in Orange County.

Words can't describe what you all have done for me. I had more love shown to me here than any other time in my life. The staff helped me believe in myself, helped me get a job and daycare, and what I can't believe is they even got me a car! A car! I still cry when I think about it. Thank you, thank you thank you."

JACOB'S HOUSE: TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

Monica & Francisco's Story -

"It is hard to find a place to go when you have a family of seven! We had been struggling for some time before we became homeless. Francisco works very hard, but still we found ourselves further and further behind on our bills. When our car broke down that was the final straw. We knew we had to leave our apartment or be evicted, but it didn't seem like any shelter would take a family with six kids. Thankfully Family Promise took us in. While we were there we were able to save for a down payment as well as pay off our back owed rent. We don't know what we would have done without you."

OUR SECOND GALA DINNER




IN-KIND DONATIONS

Our Programs – How We Serve

Interfaith Hospitality Network - Emergency Shelter Program

Our Interfaith Hospitality Network is a congregationally based response to homelessness. Congregations of all denominations and faiths open up their facilities to homeless families, allowing up to four families at a time to stay as the guests of the faith community. Congregations prepare three meals a day for the families, and volunteers from the congregations spend their evenings with the families themselves.

Participants in the program also receive comprehensive, individualized case-management at our Family Resource Center in Orange, CA. This includes but is not limited to job and credit counseling, resume writing, welfare advocacy, budgeting classes, and individual and family therapy. With the assistance of wrap-around care, participant families typically return to full independence within 2-3 months.

Jacob's House - Transitional Housing Program

Jacob's House offers transitional, low-cost housing for homeless families for up to six months. Families who participate in the program are typically employed full time, and focus on paying back debts and saving while in the program. Families have the same case-management available to them as in our congregational program.

New in 2014! - Our Supplemental Nutrition Program

One of the most common needs reported by our families following their return to housing is continued assistance with food. In order to serve this need in 2014 we will be beginning to offer non-perishable food items to both our families and to the local community.

Our Commitment to our Families:

We Promise to enable children to stay in their home school whenever possible, to continue to be involved in school activities, and to receive the tutoring and attention they need to thrive.

We Promise to empower parents to return to stability and full independence as quickly as possible, and to escape the poverty trap that is recurring and chronic homelessness.

We Promise to continue to provide two years of continued care to every family that graduates from our program, to ensure that they are never homeless again.


